Gloves help prevent splinter penetration and support reduction in cross contamination. Due to potential cross contamination of shared safety gloves, we advise archers to bring their own.	2
Equipment left behind by Archers who have left the Range	Cross contamination from Target Pins and Faces.	All	2	1	3	Any and All Target Faces, Pins and associated Boss equipment left by Archers will be removed and discarded to waste	1
Becoming ill whilst on the Archery Range.
